## FLU SHOT CLINIC

The Southwest Utah Public Health Department will hold a Flu Shot Clinic in the Santa Clara City Town Hall Banquet Room on Monday October 18, 2010 from 9:00 a.m. —Noon. The seasonal flu shot includes the H1N1 vaccine this year. The cost is \$25. Medicare, Select Health and PEHP insurances are also accepted. Santa Clara City Town Hall is located at 2603 Santa Clara Drive. Please enter thru the front door and then left into the banquet room for the flu shot clinic.

## MAYOR'S NOTES OCTOBER 2010

The mountains are showing their fall colors and I can smell pine nuts cooking. Friday night football, deer jerky; Swiss Days, cooler temperatures, the Marathon, the signs of the fall season are all around us. This is a great time of year so be sure you take a few moments and get outside and enjoy it.

While you are out there check out the new LED street lights and let the City know what you think. This past spring the City received a grant from UAMPS, our electrical power supply partner, to install energy efficient LED street lights throughout the City. City Crews began installing the new street lights during the summer on residential service streets in the Heights and the Valley. The new LED lights are very different from the older Cobra heads. They direct the light downward on the street and eliminate much of the light pollution on adjacent properties thus preserving the night sky and saving the City approximately 30% in energy costs. This is a significant cost savings for the Utility Department, something the City Council felt was important.

But the new LED street lights also appear much dimmer than the old lights and immediately some City residents expressed concerns with public safety and the security of our neighborhoods. As a result of those concerns the City Council has requested the Utility Department suspend the installation of the remaining lights, and install several alternative energy efficient heads with brighter lamps at different locations within the City for review and consideration by the residents.

The City Council is sensitive to the concerns of citizens and would like to hear from you on this issue. Watch future issues of the newsletter to find out where the alternative streetlights have been installed and take a few minutes to visit the areas and drop the City an email (via the website) or contact a member of the City Staff or City Council. Let us know what you think. If we determine the lights need to be brighter then we can work that direction.

## Fall Burn Window Open September 15—October 31, 2010

The Fall burn window opened September 15, 2010 and will be open until October 31, 2010. All burning must take place during daylight hours and be completed by dark. Fires must be attended to at all times and you need to have a hose or other fire extinguishing equipment on hand. Permission to burn is granted by calling both Burn Control at 627-4949 and Santa Clara Public Safety at 435-652-1122 ext. 222. Burn Control must be contacted the day of the burn and is available 24/7 by phone or online at [sgcity.org](http://sgcity.org)—look for the county burn permit link. Please keep the burn season safe by always calling for permission to burn. Thank you for your care and caution during the burn season.

## STORM WATER PROTECTION

In a continuing effort to maintain the quality of our ground water Santa Clara City would like to encourage all residents to participate in the Household Hazardous Waste Day. Proper disposal helps to eliminate pollutants from finding their way into the storm drain system. Help keep our waterways clean. We all live down stream!
